Well done to Y6. We are thrilled to be able to tell you that 90% of the children in Year 6 achieved the expected standard in all 3 subjects of Reading, Writing and Maths at the end of Key Stage 2. Nationally and across Hull only 61% of pupils achieved this 'gold standard'. We are very proud of the children, the teachers and yourselves for working hard and supporting the children to achieve everything that they are capable of. These results place us Number 1 in the city again which is a fantastic achievement.

Thanks to everyone who has been into school recently to take part in events. The Year 5 and 6 pupils put on a super production of Mary Poppins and it was lovely to see parents singing along with the children! Our Summer Fair was well attended and raised a fantastic £620. Thanks so much to all of the Friends of Clifton parents who helped with the organising and on the day. You were brilliant!
